



SOLDER WSL3

soldering alloy on a tin-lead base

DESCRIPTION

Stannol Solder WSL3 is a soldering alloy on a tin-lead base for the soldering of printed circuit boards in wave soldering machines and static baths.

Stannol Solder WSL3 consists of pure metals with a desoxidant additive and is manufactured in the commercially available alloys S-Sn60Pb40 or S-Sn63Pb37. The desoxidant additive has no alterative effects on the mechanical properties.

APPLICATION

The following benefits are obtainable from Stannol Solder WSL3 applications:

- a great reduction in oxide formation, i.e. maximum economy with the highest degree of economic application of the solder
- consistent soldering results from the optimal wetting properties of the solder
- reduction in the formation of bridges or cones (reduction in the short circuiting hazard); the tinned surface is blank, bright and shiny
